

# MAY 9TH, 2010 – SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



In last Sunday's gospel Jesus cautioned us to love not on our own terms but as he loves. This week he commands us to keep not our word but his word. To help us to keep his word, Jesus promises us a divine indwelling through which we are re-created as persons able to live and love as Jesus himself did. We are new creation empowered to continue, in peace and fearlessness, the mission of Jesus in the world. To be created anew means that we share in the life of the risen Lord—in a very real way, we share in Jesus' identity. This is the gift of baptism: that we are made members of the Body of Christ. As members of his body, we can truly keep his word and carry on his saving mission. Keeping Jesus' word means that we open our hearts to his presence, allow him to change us. The word of Jesus is a promise of a new relationship with him and his Father, where God comes and dwells within us through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The radiant vision of God's dwelling among us (see second reading) is realized when disciples take up the practical way of life Jesus commands us in the gospel: to love, keep his word and believe. To take up this challenging way of life Jesus sends his Spirit, give his peace and removes our fears.

Living the paschal mystery is as demanding as loving with the same self-sacrifice as Jesus. As disciples we are never alone in our spiritual journey. God is always present dwelling within us and giving us the strength we need to be faithful to Jesus' commands, keeping His word as our own word.

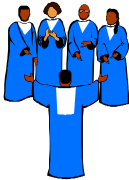
