

NOVEMBER 21ST, 2010 – FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING



This Sunday we celebrate Christ as our King. Christ is no ordinary ruler, however. His kingship is dependent not upon human bloodline but upon our relationship to his heavenly Father. Through him we become members of his Body, the church. He leads this Body with vision and promise, hope and new life and to those who are faithful, he grants the inheritance of eternal life in the heavenly kingdom.

How does the image “king” refer to Christ in our relationship to him? By naming him “king” we acknowledge him and his way of living as the wellspring of our goodness and salvation. We acknowledge our status as his “subjects” called to relate to others as he did. We acknowledge our shared inheritance as the “saints in the light” who receive life through him. By naming Christ our King we identify him as the One who offers us the fullness of life in his kingdom both now and forever. It also means we accept the responsibility to be faithful to the demands required of those who follow him.

The cross is where we least expect a king to be. Yet this is where we find Jesus. The cross is where we least want to be. Yet this is how God’s kingdom is established and where our discipleship begins: allowing ourselves to be crucified on the cross of self-giving. Jesus demonstrates his kingship by not saving himself but by saving others. He also assures faithful disciples that the heavenly kingdom awaits those who remain with him to the end even if that means living the cross in our everyday life. This means we live in a self-giving way because only thorough goodness expressed in reaching out to others is God’s reign at hand.
