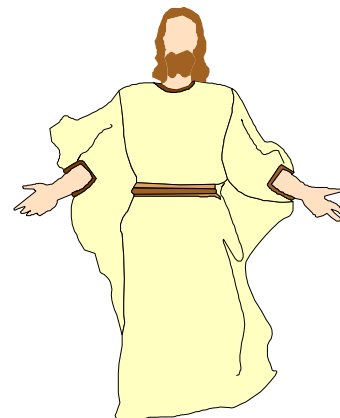


APRIL 4TH, 2010 – EASTER SUNDAY

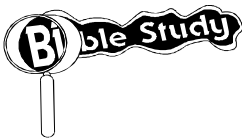

STEWARDSHIP: A Disciple's Response

In the second reading today, St. Paul reminds the Colossians that they have been raised with Christ, exhorting them to "seek things that are above, not things that are on earth." We, too, have been raised with Christ. Let us rejoice and be glad!

"What do I own, and what owns me?" These words of the late Archbishop Thomas Murphy capture St. Paul's message. The "things of earth" — our possessions — in and of themselves are neither good nor bad. When we use them to meet our real needs and the needs of our families, they are good, because they are being used as God intended. We own them; we use them for good. But possessions have a way of trapping us, causing us to fixate on them, always wanting more. They come to own us, and when they do, they block our path to Christ. The steward keeps his or her eyes on the things of heaven, refusing to fall into the trap.
