The largest concentration of Maronites is in Lebanon, so many from this community are Lebanese. Fr. Daniel Fares O.A.M. has been coming to our parish once a month to celebrate the Liturgy according to the Maronite Rite on Sundays at 5:00pm. He usually stays in the rectory for a few days on each visit and he spends time with members of his community here. Fr. Daniel is the pastor of Our Lady of Peace Parish, which is a Maronite Catholic Church in Calgary. He is a joy to have in the rectory and sometimes brings me Lebanese treats. Welcome Fr. Daniel and the Maronite community!
