
## 3RD SUNDAY OF LENT - MARCH 20, 2022

**SYNOD 21-2023:** Two Conversation Circles were held on Wednesday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, one in-person at the church and one via Zoom, and both went well. No doubt the Holy Spirit is guiding participants and our parish's Synodal Process as we start our journey. We were happy to see that our participants were prepared and committed to engage enthusiastically in the listening and discussion, as well

as provide inspired and thoughtful conversation with open hearts and minds, and most essentially with respect for each other. We also saw that some participants were more concerned by issues at the level of the parish and others by issues at the level of the Universal Church; nevertheless, everyone shared the same love and hopes for our parish and the Church. **Another two sessions will be taking place Saturday morning, March 19<sup>th</sup>, one in-person at the church at 10:15am and one via Zoom, at 10:00am.** A reminder and link have been sent out to the in-person and online participants, respectively. **The remaining sessions are: Wednesday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, at 7:00pm, in-person; Thursday, March 24<sup>th</sup>, 7:00pm, in-person; Thursday, March 24<sup>th</sup>, 7:00pm, via Zoom.** The participants of these sessions will receive a gentle reminder 2 days before their sessions. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit continues to guide us as we proceed with the rest of the Synod Conversation Circles.

**HOLY HOUR FOR PEACE IN UKRAINE:** The Archbishop has asked every parish to hold a public prayer service for peace in Ukraine. Therefore, we will be having a special Holy Hour next **Sunday, March 27<sup>th</sup>, at 1:30pm.** Everyone is encouraged to participate so that our cry for peace may be even stronger as we present our petition before the throne of God.

**PRAYING WITH TRUSTFUL SURRENDER:** The great spiritual director St. Claude de la Colombiere said, "It is all the more remarkable that the more we submit to God's will, the more He tries to meet our wishes."
