SYNOD 21-2023: On Sunday, March 13th, our synod **facilitators** Randy Castellarin, Paul Fang, Charles Morris, and Tom Nowak along with our parish synod **recorders** Bernie Chow, Angie Dee, Julia Magee, and Molly Sung will review the training material provided by the Archdiocese to learn how to facilitate or record input from participants in a Conversation

Circle. The main piece of the training is for our volunteers to actually experience the Conversation Circle process which is embodied in the concept of "Community Discernment." Community Discernment involves invoking the Holy Spirit to guide community input and decision making. I think you will see that this input is not about offering up opinions, it is about what has come to the top of your heart during prayer. **The parish needs your input, and the Church needs it...please register to participate. Sign-up sheets are in the church vestibule.** Last day to register for an in-person or zoom session is **March 14th**. The in-person sessions will be held in the North Vestibule of the church. You will be contacted on March 14th, to confirm your session. As an alternative to attending a Conversation Circle you may drop off your **written submission** in the parish collection basket or you can do an **electronic submission** by visiting the Archdiocesan website at rcav.org/synod/participate.
