### Merry Christmas!

After we've spent four weeks contemplating our great need for God, the reality that meets us at Christmas is an indescribable gift: The Father has answered our prayers, sending his Son as one like ourselves, immersing himself in human life and speaking words we can understand. No wonder we say "Merry Christmas!"

It's good to remember the medieval origins of this very word: "Christ's Mass," where we begin our celebration of this season that lasts until the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

**Did You Know?** The birthplace of Jesus—Bethlehem— means "house of bread." Many ancient commentators interpreted this as pre-figuring the Eucharist. Jesus came to earth in the "house of bread" and comes to us in the form of Living Bread every time we receive Him in the Blessed Sacrament.

# January 1st— Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God

For Catholics, December 25 is only the beginning. Our celebration continues as other

feasts shed their own unique light on the gift of Jesus.

January 1 is both the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, and a day of prayer for world peace. We can deepen our celebration of the New Year by our prayer that our families and our world be open to the peace Jesus offers.



## January 3rd—Solemnity of The Most Holy Name of Jesus

In the musical, *West Side Story*, a young man falls in love with a girl and sings about the meaning of her name "Maria" has for him: "Say it loud and there's music playing; say it soft and it's almost like

praying." The name of someone we love carries within it the meaning that person has for us.

"Jesus" is the name given to the Lord by the angel in a dream to Joseph and at the Annunciation to Mary. It means "Savior." Devotion to the name of Jesus was popularized by the Franciscan St. Bernardine of Siena who created the "IHS" logo to represent the name of Jesus. He was also responsible for the addition of the name "Jesus" to the Hail Mary. The old Vesper hymn for this feast, Jesu Dulcis Memoria, captures the tender devotion and regard every Christian should have toward the name of Jesus.

The name of Jesus reminds us of all the ways Jesus is part of our life today. In fact, the "Jesus Prayer" has become very popular as a contemplative prayer in our time. Saying the name of Jesus slowly over and over is not "almost like praying," it is praying... personally and profoundly at levels deeper than words. And it is a path of prayer open to all of us. (S. 
