Building our Parish Community

Twice last week, while I was at my office in the pastoral centre, I heard "Congratulations!" Both times I asked what I had done, and discovered it wasn't what I had done, but what you have accomplished: Holy Name of Jesus currently tops Project Advance's list of parishes over their goal!

To be precise, we are 414% over the Archdiocesan target, having raised **\$133,433** to date. This is remarkable, although not that surprising given the proven generosity of our parishioners.

My heartfelt thanks to everyone who contributed. And to those who haven't yet made their gift or pledge, I want to invite you to be part of this success story. The campaign is not over! We set a parish goal of **\$150,000** to make sure we have enough funds to do a good job on our project of creating a more welcoming space at the entrance to the church, with funds left over for a small crying room.

We're still a bit short on that goal. But with just **\$27,000** to go, I am confident that the Fall phase of our campaign will raise that sum. We are close but not at the top of the Archdiocese in terms of parish participation. Only one-quarter of our registered households have participated in Project Advance so far. A modest gift from those who have not yet responded will help us achieve our financial and participation goals.

Your contribution to the campaign is an act of Christian charity (the first quarter of the funds have gone to the Archdiocese, including its charitable and educational works), an exercise of Christian stewardship in the spirit of the Gospel, and a vote of confidence in our parish's mission to be a welcoming place.

As the late Dag Hammarskjold, secretary general of the UN, wrote: For what has been, thanks! For what will be, Yes!
