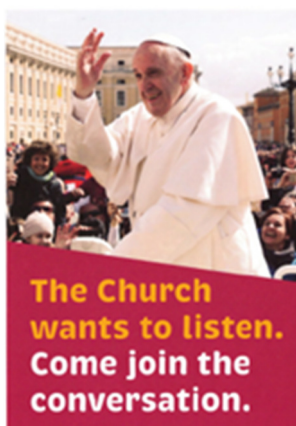

HOLY HOUR FOR PEACE IN UKRAINE: The Archbishop has asked every parish to hold a public prayer service for peace in Ukraine. Therefore, we will be having a special Holy Hour on **Sunday, March 27th**, at **1:30pm**. Everyone is encouraged to participate so that our cry for peace may be even stronger as we present our petition before the throne of God.



SYNOD 21-2023: Two in-person and one Zoom sessions were held last Saturday morning and Wednesday evening, respectively. At these sessions, we continued to observe, as we did at the previous sessions, the same level of enthusiasm and eagerness from our participants to engage in the listening and discussion, and with attention and respect for others' thoughts and insights. The participants also expressed similar concerns about the challenges that churches encounter at present, both at the parish level and at the level of Universal Church. Worries about that the negative impacts on the Church and our faith by societal issues such as declining standards of morality, social injustice, political correctness, environment damage, were also shared in the discussion. More opportunities, like this Synod, for participants to give feedback in a safe/judgement-free environment were among the valuable suggestions received. Two sessions on the evening of Thursday, March 24th, in-person and via Zoom, are the last sessions scheduled for the Synodal process at HNJ.
