## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...

Dear fellow parishioners,

Today I begin a regular section in the bulletin called "From the Pastor's Desk..." where I can let you know what I've been up to and update you on the goings and happenings of our parish community.

This week I want to provide a brief update on our Hall renovations. As of now, our design committee has been meeting and exchanging many emails to make decisions about any changes that might be made to the space. Our recent focus has been on the kitchen, meeting room, and potential café/lounge. I would like to address the café/lounge: As you may know, I have been somewhat focused on ways that we can begin to reach out more as a parish. I see the Hall renovation as an opportunity to create a space that is welcoming and cozy where people, young and not-so-young, would love to spend time and hang out, have discussions, etc. The café is meant to be this space. It will be located where the stage currently is. Having a café does not necessarily mean it will be used as a functioning café in the strict sense of the term. To be honest, I would love to have a barista serving at certain times, but that is a decision to be determined later. Rather, the main goal is to have a comfortable space where parishioners and visitors alike can enjoy at all times. Self-serve coffee or tea could also be available.

Another area that will be improved are the washrooms. The plan is to build a men's washroom on the opposite side of the hallway where the current washrooms are. The current washrooms would then be renovated to become the women's washroom. This would increase the number of toilets in the women's washroom to 5, and the number of toilets in the men's washroom to 2, plus 2 urinals. Each washroom will have a wheelchair accessible toilet stall.

I hope to be able to publish the renovation plans in the coming weeks so that the whole parish can give feedback. Of course, I'm open to suggestions or comments at any time.
