PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD - APRIL 10, 2022

PLEASE NOTE: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence throughout the Church.

Abstinence: Fridays throughout the year are days of abstinence from meat, unless a solemnity is celebrated on that day. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops permits the substitution of an act of piety or charity in place of abstinence. The law of abstinence forbids the use of meat; but not of eggs, the products of milk or condiments made of animal fat.

N.B. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday abstinence from meat is obligatory.

Fasting: The law of fasting applies to those between the ages of fourteen and sixty years unless impeded by health concerns. "Fasting allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening, observing—as far as quality and quantity are concerned—approved local custom." (*Canons 1250–53, Poenitemini III-1 & 2*).
