A reading from the book of Wisdom 3

The souls of the just are in God's hands, and no torment, in death itself, has power to so; think their end loss, their leaving us, annihilation; but all is well with them. The world sees nothing but the pains they endure; they themselves have eyes only for what is immortal; so light their suffering, so great the gain they win! God, all the while, did but

test them, and testing them found them worthy of him. His gold, tried in the crucible, his burnt-sacrifice, graciously accepted, they do but wait for the time of their deliverance; then they will shine out, these just souls, unconquerable as the sparks that break out, now here, now there, among the stubble.

## **Indulgences for Souls in Purgatory**

- 1. Visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the first to the eighth of November; on other days of the year it is partial.
- 2. Visit a church on All Saints' Day (November 1), All Souls Day on (November 2), or Sunday November 5. When visiting the church it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited
- To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary also to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father. The three conditions may be fulfilled several days or before or after the performance of the visit; it is, however, fitting that Communion be received and the prayer for the intention of the Holy Father be said on the same day as the visit.
- The condition of praying for the intention of the Holy Father is fully satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary. A plenary indulgence can be acquired only once in the course of the day.

MASS INTENTION ENVELOPES for Holy Souls are in the vestibule. If you would like to request a Mass please write the name/ names on the envelope. The suggested offering for one Mass is \$10 [cash only]. Please use one envelope for each Mass you wish to request. Masses will not be announced at Holy Name of Jesus. Most of these Masses will be offered by retired or missionary priests.
