MESSAGE FROM MSGR. SMITH:

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It may as come as a surprise, but priests do not like talking about money--and certainly, I don't like doing so even before taking over as pastor!

However, for a variety of reasons (not the work you see going on around the rectory and parish office, the cost of which had not yet been invoiced, and which will be met by parish savings), we do not have enough money in our current account to pay the bills!

So I would like to remind you that a parish can limp along without a pastor but can't keep moving without your continuing support. If you have fallen behind in your Sunday offerings, this may be a good time to catch up.

This is also an opportunity to remind you of the possibility and convenience of regular monthly giving by credit card. Please contact the parish office if you would like to use this method.

The current shortfall notwithstanding, I am very grateful for the sacrifices you make for the parish and, together with St. Paul, I would like to say, "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."

On June 17<sup>th</sup>, Sister Maria Serra, F.S.E. gave our parishioners a beautiful talk: **The Mystery of the Eucharist: Furnace of Divine Love** organized by our Catholic Women's League.
