Born in Kerala, India, after college joined the Dominican Order in 1977. After completing philosophical and theological studies at St. Charles Seminary, Nagpur, India, Fr. Jose was ordained to priesthood in his home parish in Kerala on April 3, 1989.

His first assignment after ordination was to the Dominican community in Mangalore. While serving the community as its financial administrator, he pursued studies in Indian Civil Law at Mangalore University. After graduating in Civil Law, was appointed as the legal advisor of the Dominican Province of India.

this week: all they can say is no! But plan to accompany those you ask. We're using our tidied-up parish hall, so the evening starts at **7:00pm**.


