#### AN EMAIL FROM THE PASTOR

Reading Fr. Jacques Philippe's book *Called to Life* on my holiday, I came across this thought-provoking quotation from Etty Hillesum, a young Jewish woman from Holland who died at Auschwitz. I thought it well worth sharing with you:

I am having an ever-stronger experience these last days: in my least daily actions and sensations a hint of eternity creeps in. I am not the only one who is tired, sick, sad, or anguished. I am united with millions of others across centuries. All that is what life is made of. Life is beautiful and full of meaning in its absurdity if you know how to take it as a whole. So life in some sense or other forms a perfect whole. As soon as we refuse or wish to eliminate certain elements, as soon as we follow our own pleasure or caprice by accepting one aspect of life and rejecting another, then life becomes in effect absurd. Once the sense of the whole of it is lost, everything becomes arbitrary.
