
STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI: Sunday June 19th, immediately after the **11:00AM Mass (between 12:00PM—1:00PM approximately)**, all are invited to celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi by walking in our parish's **Procession of the Blessed Sacrament**. The procession will be led by the Holy Eucharist carried in a monstrance by Fr. Rodney, beginning at the church's front doors on Cambie Street, followed by all parishioners who wish to come along. The procession will continue into Queen Elizabeth Park (See Map) and pause for prayer and adoration at the lookout to Quarry Park before returning by the same route we came. There will be singing, ringing of bells, and public witness of Christ's love in our world. Come, let us adore our Lord!
