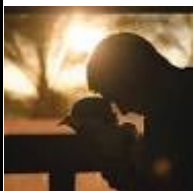

PREP is designed to assist parents with children attending public school, private non-Catholic School, and Home-School (Kindergarten – Grade 7). It is a 7-year religious education program designed to run parallel to a child's elementary school education.

An important component of this program is to help prepare children for the Sacraments of 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation, 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion and Confirmation with a goal to draw them closer to Jesus Christ.

PREP classes will be held on **Thursday evenings from 6:00 – 7:15pm**.
