## THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS PRAYING FOR THE DEAD

**DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER** we especially remember our deceased family, friends and benefactors. As in the past our Parish Book of Remembrance with the names of our deceased friends and loved ones will be placed at the foot of the altar for all Masses during the month of November.

### Indulgences for Souls in Purgatory

1. Visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the first to the eighth of November; on other days of the year it is partial.

2. Visit a church on All Saints' Day (November 1), All Souls Day on (November 2), or Sunday November 5. When visiting the church it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited

- To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary also to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father. The three conditions may be fulfilled several days or before or after the performance of the visit; it is, however, fitting that Communion be received and the prayer for the intention of the Holy Father be said on the same day as the visit.
- The condition of praying for the intention of the Holy Father is fully satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary. A plenary indulgence can be acquired only once in the course of the day. **The 9:00am Masses on November 1 and 2 satisfy the above condition; so does the 7:00pm Holy Hour on November 2.**

**ALL SOULS' DAY Thursday, November 2, Mass: 9:00am; Holy Hour with Music: 7:00pm.**

**N.B.** Mass Intention envelopes for Holy Souls are in the vestibule. If you would like to request a Mass please write the name/ names on the envelope. The suggested offering for one Mass is \$10 [cash only]. Please use one envelope for each Mass you wish to request. Masses will not be announced at Holy Name of Jesus. Most of these Masses will be offered by retired or missionary priests.
