**FROM THE PASTOR**

As I write this, my holiday is almost over, but I am still only halfway through Fr. Jacques Philippe’s book *Called to Life*. It takes me time to absorb his profound thoughts! Here’s one passage I found very challenging; I particularly liked the final sentence:

In his encyclical *Novo Millennio Ineunte*, laying out his plan for the Church of the third millennium, Pope John Paul says that a Christian who does not pray is a Christian “at risk.” I’d add that the same is true of a Christian who does not regularly read the Word of God. It is a matter of life or death: “Not by bread alone does man live, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of the Lord” (Deut 8:3). The world is too confused, and we are too weak, for us to try to live without the light and strength that come from the Bible.
