# PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD - APRIL 2, 2023

**PLEASE NOTE:** Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence throughout the Church.

**Abstinence:** Fridays throughout the year are days of abstinence from meat, unless a solemnity is celebrated on that day. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops permits the substitution of an act of piety or charity in place of abstinence. The law of abstinence forbids the use of meat; but not of eggs, the products of milk or condiments made of animal fat.

**N.B. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday abstinence from meat is obligatory.**

**Fasting:** The law of fasting applies to those between the ages of fourteen and sixty years unless impeded by health concerns. "Fasting allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening, observing—as far as quality and quantity are concerned—approved local custom." (*Canons 1250–53, Poenitemini III-1 &2*).

## Are We Amazed by His Love?

- by Pope Francis (shortened version)



Every year this liturgy leaves us amazed: we pass from the joy of welcoming Jesus as he enters Jerusalem to the sorrow of watching him condemned to death then crucified. As Saint Francis of Assisi contemplated the crucified Lord, he was amazed that his friars did not weep. What about us? Can we still be moved by God's love? Have we lost the ability to be amazed by him? Why? Maybe our faith has grown dull from habit. Maybe we remain trapped in our regrets and allow ourselves to be crippled by our disappointments. Maybe we have lost all our trust or even feel worthless.

Let us start over from amazement. Let us gaze upon Jesus on the cross and say to Him: *"Lord, how much you love me! How precious I am to you!"* Let us be amazed by Jesus so that we can start living again, for the grandeur of life lies not in possessions and promotions; the grandeur of life is in discovering that we are loved.

Brothers and sisters, let us be filled with amazement as we gaze upon the crucified Lord. May we, too, say with the centurion: *"You are truly the Son of God! You are my God."*

We adore you, O Christ, and we bless You, because by your Holy Cross you have redeemed the world. Amen.

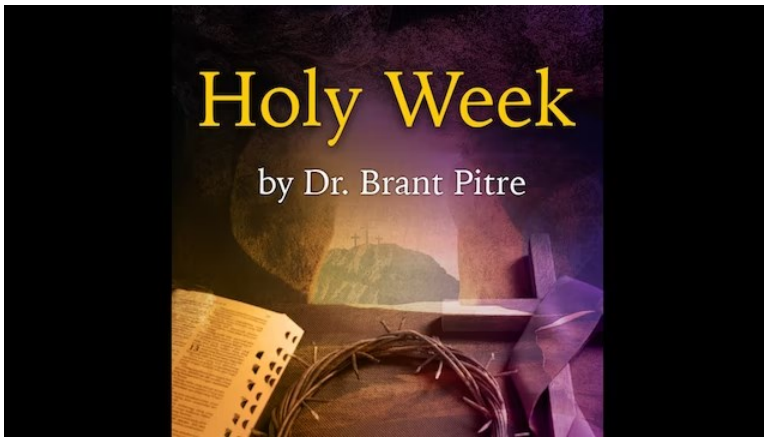

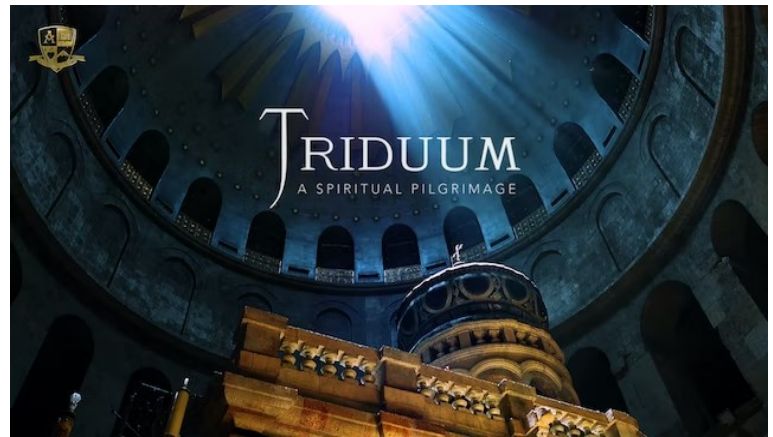

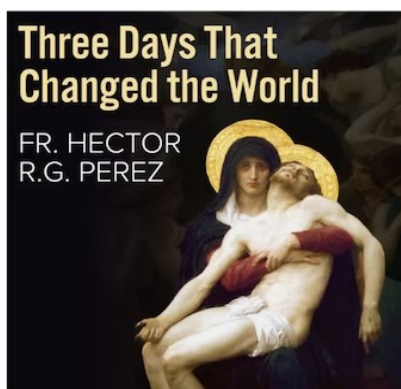
