## 8TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - FEBRUARY 27, 2022

**ASH WEDNESDAY (MARCH 2<sup>nd</sup>):** There will be two Masses 9:00am & 7:00pm.

**Abstinence:** All Catholics fourteen years of age or older are bound to abstain from meat on Fridays throughout the year unless a solemnity is celebrated on that day. **N.B.** On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday abstinence from meat is obligatory. On other Fridays throughout the year, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops permits the substitution of an act of piety or charity in place of abstinence. The **law of abstinence forbids the use of meat**; but not of eggs, the products of milk or condiments made from animal fat.

**Fasting:** The law of fasting applies to those between the ages of eighteen and sixty years unless impeded by health concerns. "Fasting allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening, observing—as far as quality and quantity are concerned—local custom." (*Canons 1250-53, Poenitemini III-1 & 2*).

**PLEASE NOTE: On Fridays during Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross at 6:30pm followed by Mass.**
