IMPORTANT UPDATE: Our future pastor, Msgr. Smith celebrated Mass on Wednesday and mentioned the following:

Msgr. Smith serves 4 jobs in the Archdiocese of Vancouver, and although he is currently our Parish Administrator, he is unable to be present to provide pastoral care for us until mid-July. There are priests scheduled to celebrate daily and Sunday Masses at Holy Name until mid-July. However, due to availability of priests, the schedule is subject to change. In the absence of a priest, a deacon may be sent to our parish to provide a communion service (not mass). If a communion service is not possible, Monsignor encourages us to pray the Rosary together. Also, our regular Holy Hour events and confessions may be cancelled without the possibility advance notice. Please of giving check holynameparish.ca/mass for the latest updates.
