HOLY NAME OF JESUS PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM (PREP): Let your children draw closer to Jesus through our Parish Religious Education Program. PREP is designed to assist parents with children attending public school, private non-Catholic School, and Home-School (Kindergarten – Grade 7). It is a 7-year Religious Education Program designed to run parallel to a child’s elementary school education.

PREP helps to prepare children for the Sacraments of 1st Reconciliation, 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation by having a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
