## From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear fellow parishioners,

This week work will finally begin on our drainage system. As you know, the area on the south side of the church under the overhang flooded last November. The drainage system could not handle the amount of water and the church hall flooded.

We approached four different companies to assess the problem and to get a quote to fix the issue. Each company offered a different solution to fix the problem and so the quotes they provided were wildly different. After a lot of consultation, we have chosen a company who offered the following solution: Since the majority of water buildup comes from the four corners of the church roof during a rainfall, the first goal is to improve the drainage at those four corners. The drainage company, Coastline Projects Ltd., will begin with those four corners and from there they will be able to assess the rest of the drainage pipes. If they discover that these pipes have been compromised, we will need to replace them as well. They will also install new floor drains in other areas around the church. Unfortunately, some of the vegetation around the church will need to be removed in order to access the drains. We will be working with our landscaper to improve these areas after the drainage project is complete. The total contract price for the drain project itself is \$61,740. If the company discovers that more pipes need to be replaced, this cost will go up.

On another note, we have now received our final settlement from our insurance company for the flood damage in the hall. We received \$37,440.31 for the emergency restoration, which included cutting the bottom of the drywall and removing carpet and some tiles. We then paid the restoration company with this money. We also received \$25,380.97 for subsequent hall restoration. In total we received \$62,821.28. If we wish to upgrade and modernize our hall, we will necessarily have to add more money to this. I will provide updates as we establish our budget.

Thank you so much to everyone for your patience. Thank you also for your continued generosity to the parish. Let us pray for the success of these projects.
