SYNOD 21-2023: The two sessions that took place on Thursday, March 24th wrapped up the Conversation Circles of Synodal process at Holy Name of Jesus. The Synod team would like to sincerely thank our participants for their trust in us and for their thoughtful and insightful spiritual sharing. For most participants and the Synod team members, this Synod process with its unique nature was their very first experience of

this kind. The enthusiastic responses we witnessed at the discussion sessions showed us beyond a doubt that this has been a spiritual journey that has been both significant and inspirational for our participants; they witnessed firsthand one another's love and hopes for the parish and for the Universal Church. As the Synod Coordinator of HNJ, I would also like to personally extend my utmost appreciation to the Synod committee, the facilitators, recorders, as well as the parishioners who participated in the Conversation Circles and those who shared their thoughts in writing. The next step involves combing all the sharing we collected from discussions and written submissions into a report and sending it to the Archdiocesan Synod Committee. We will also publish the report and share it with our parishioners. Taking into account submissions from all the parishes in the Archdiocese, the Archdiocesan Synod Committee will prepare a document for the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB). Ultimately, the information will be used, in conjunction with the Bishops' input, to determine the future of our Church. Parishioners who still wish to participate may do so by visiting the Archdiocesan Website (rcav.org/synod) and submit their individual contribution.
