to welcome Archbishop Miller to the parish for the solemn occasion of the Rite of Installation of our new pastor, Msgr. Gregory Smith. A pastor is neither hired by parishioners, nor does he get to select his desired parish. Instead, priests (as pastors) respect the authority of their bishop who weighs the pastoral needs of a parish and prayerfully – with his advisors – attempts to match them with a priest qualified to meet those needs.

The installation of a new pastor is therefore a significant moment in the life of a parish. The whole community is invited to attend the Installation to recognize Msgr. Smith as our new shepherd and to express our unity with the Archbishop.

A few key moments will take place within the regular Sunday Mass, including a homily delivered by the Archbishop and the presentation of the new pastor to the community by the Archbishop.

The installation will be followed by a reception in the hall with the Archbishop. All are welcome to attend.

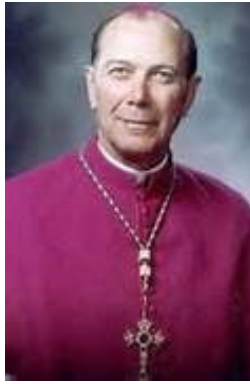
PREP helps to prepare children for the Sacraments of 1st Reconciliation, 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation.

**DEATH OF ARCHBISHOP ADAM EXNER, OMI:** Archbishop Exner, who served as Archbishop of Vancouver from 1991 to 2004 died peacefully September 5<sup>th</sup>, at the age of 94, in his residence in Grayson, Saskatchewan.
