This Sunday we observe the **World Day of the Sick**, introduced by Pope John Paul II as for the invitation to pray for those suffering from illnesses and those who provide care for them.

ASH WEDNESDAY is February 14. Masses at **9:00 AM** and **7:00 PM**. In accordance with the prescriptions of canon 1253, Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence in Canada. Everyone 14 and over is

bound by the law of abstinence from meat. Those 18—60 are bound by the law of fasting, unless impeded by health concerns. Fasting means eating one full meal a day and two small (half-sized meals). Obviously these are minimum requirements and we should do our best to take penance more seriously for our age and health allows.

Our Lenten faith studies begin this week:

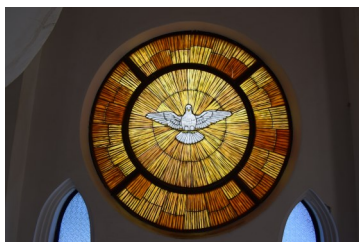
Discovery on Monday evenings at 7:00pm begins on February 19, led

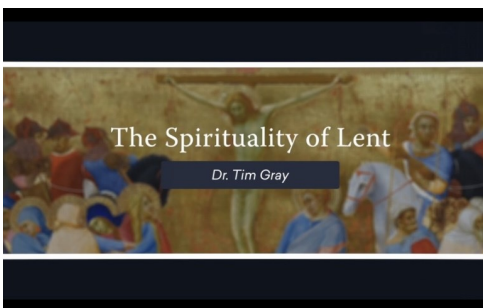
