HOW TO INVITE SOMEONE TO ALPHA

It isn't always easy inviting our family members, friends, classmates, or co-workers to "just come and check out" the Catholic faith. Mass can be disorienting or intimidating for someone who has been away for some time or someone who has no religious formation.

We need to provide a welcoming, hospitable, friendly, and non-judgmental place to invite people to. A place where they feel they can be themselves and ask questions.

That's what Alpha is.

If you don't think you're ready to invite a certain someone to Alpha, then ask the Holy Spirit to do the heavy lifting for you! God has someone in mind for you to introduce to Jesus. You just need to ask Him who it is.

Step 1: Identify someone in a spirit of humility.

Step 2: Intercede for that person in communion with the Holy Spirit.

Step 3: Connect in Eucharistic friendship.

Step 4: Invite that person on a path most suitable for him or her.

CARLO ACUTIS

The first millennial Saint a.k.a. "God's Influencer"

Carlo, a British-born Italian who died of leukemia in 2006 at age 15, was an ordinary boy who loved playing video games such as Halo, Mario, and Pokémon, although his mother claims he limited himself to just one hour of gaming a week to avoid addiction. Carlo learned several computer coding languages before his death and built websites to spread his faith.

Carlo's sainthood is credited with healing a 4-year-old Brazilian boy who had a serious pancreatic malformation and a 21-year-old Costa Rican woman who was near death after a bicycle accident.

Saint Carlo Acutis, patron of the internet and "God's influencer", be our friend in heaven and pray for us, that we who struggle with internet and gaming addictions may be healed by the Holy Spirit with gifts of fortitude and self-control.



PIER GIORGIO FRASSATI

Patron for youth, young adults, athletes, and "ordinary people"

Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901-1925) was a young man filled with joy who lived a life of charity, faith and social justice. Upon completing his studies in engineering, his father gave him a large fund as a graduation present, and he chose to give it to the poor instead of using it for himself.

Frassati was considered extraordinary in his "ordinariness", and is a great role model for ordinary people who strive to live their everyday lives to the fullest.

He saw many parallels between Catholic life and his favorite pastime sport, mountainclimbing. After what would become his final climb he wrote a simple note on a photo: "Verso L'Alto", which means "to the heights."

Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati, pray for us that we may encounter Christ in our lives to the fullest.


